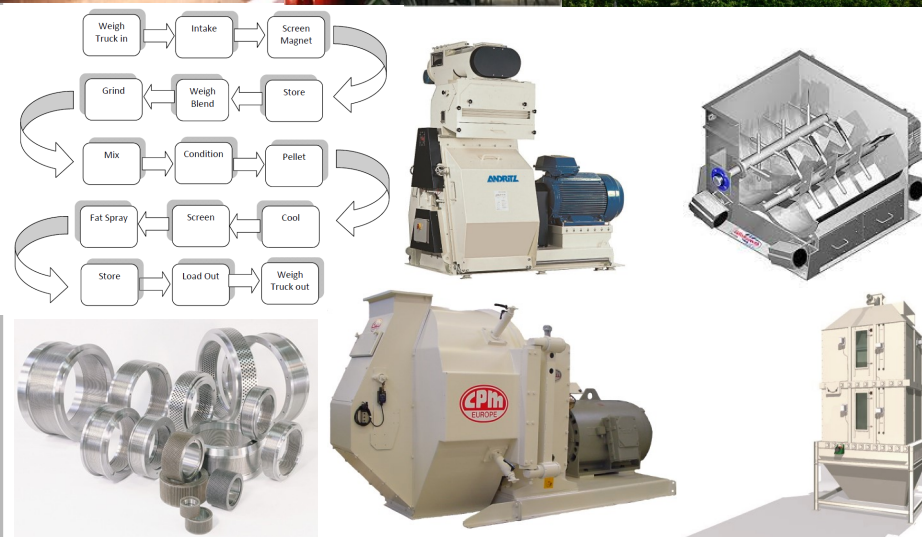

BCFTA - Feed Production Foundation Course

This is the Fourth time BCFTA have run this course and again will make use of the Feed Design Labs purpose designed facilities in the Netherlands.

Animal feed manufacture plays a key role in producing safe and high quality feed that is essential for the production of products such as milk, eggs and meat.

The quality of feed is safeguarded by the skills and knowledge of those involved in the whole process of the production of feed.

The three day BCFTA Foundation course in Feed Production has been designed to allow those directly involved within the feed manufacturing process and those supplying the industry to gain skills and knowledge of the process.

The course is an intensive one covering raw materials from supply to the mill or blending plant via processing, including quality controls required, to supply as a finished feed.

The aim of the course is that the participant will gain knowledge and insight into the feed production process, the effects of the production process on feed quality and the safety and importance of this link in the human food chain.

Target attendees:

Whilst the course is aimed at those directly involved in the production of Blends and Compounds it will also be applicable to suppliers of raw materials and others involved within production and supply of animal feed.

What's Included?

The BCFTA Management Committee have approved again a significant subsidy for member companies staff to enable this course to take place.

The charge made includes, costs associated with the course including accommodation and travelling to and from the Netherlands from an airport as local as possible to the attendees

Areas covered by the course:

The Course is taking place in the Netherlands using a purpose designed teaching facility and will include visits to a major manufacturer of compounding equipment and a Dutch Feed Mill.

The training will be undertaken by Dutch trainers and one English, who have considerable experience and knowledge of animal feed production and training of staff.

Over the three days the following subjects will be covered:

- Raw Materials: Links to safety;
- Nutrition: Species, Blending and Formulations
- Quality: testing, Audits & Codes of practice
- Mixing: Addition of dry and liquid materials
- Process and Feed safety: HACCP, ATEX, Cleaning
- Labelling: Legislation, what and why it is provided
- Energy Management: Covering Electricity/Gas/Oil/Water/Air
- Grinding: Why, types, controls and maintenance
- Mixing: Types, addition of small ingredients and maintenance
- Liquids: System: Types, control and maintenance
- Pelleting: Process, advantages, control, maintenance
- Steam: Principals, control, maintenance,
- Dies/Rolls: Specification, adjustment, starting a die, setting Rolls, maintenance
- Cooling: Types, controls, maintenance
- Screening: Types, maintenance
- Finished product testing: Types, location, management and reaction
- The course will conclude with a written examination covering areas the course has covered which will make use of multiple choice Questions

Course numbers are being limited to a maximum of 12 attendees
